


Horn fingering chart



- 1. Music in the classic and romantic periods customarily wrote the F clef an octave lower in some cases.
- 2. When there are two fingerings for the same note, generally the fingering written to the left is used. Alternate fingering is on the right.
- 3. The asterisk (*) indicates that the note is somewhat high.
- A: For the double horn, this is normally played in the B b horn range.
