
1.1. Can I control Omnivocal Beta using external devices like wheels?

Yes, you can control Omnivocal using hardware devices by utilizing Cubase's MIDI Remote feature. [Control Your Synths With Quick Controls](#)

1.2. I can't find the "Text" field for entering lyrics

The "Text" field is located at the far right of the info line when a note is selected. By default, other information may be displayed, causing the "Text" field to be hidden off-screen.


In that case, right-click on the Info Line and select "Set up Info Line" to reduce the types of information displayed.

1.3. Even though I'm using Cubase15, I can't launch Omnivocal Beta.

Omnivocal Beta can only be used when inserted into an instrument track. For example, if you insert it into a rack instrument, it won't launch. In that case, you'll see an error message like the one below.

1.4. Even though Solo Editor Mode is enabled on another instrument track, Omnivocal Beta's sound is still playing.

Omnivocal Beta is not muted when Solo Editor Mode is enabled on other tracks. However, when Solo Editor Mode is enabled on the Omnivocal Beta track itself, other tracks are muted.

1.5. Can I use Omnivocal Beta and its voices for commercial projects?

All voice banks can be used freely, including for commercial music, without requiring any permission or credit from Yamaha or Steinberg.
