Earlier this year, 60 performers from 11 countries* visited one of 10 locations around the world—Chicago, Hamburg, Guangzhou, New York, Los Angeles, Melbourne, Moscow, Shanghai, Toronto, and Vancouver—to create virtual audition video recordings on the **Yamaha Disklavier**, the official concert grand piano of the 2019 International e-Piano Junior Competition.

In March, these video recordings (which activated the keys and pedals of a connected Disklavier) were recreated in Lloyd Ultan Recital Hall at University of Minnesota School of Music and evaluated by a distinguished panel of judges: Amy Hamann, Sara Hamann, and Dr. Kyung R Kim.

From these recordings, 25 contestants were invited to perform at the **2019 International e-Piano Junior Competition** in Minneapolis, MN, competing for more than \$20,000 in cash and prizes.
